The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General ¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, ² decides to inform the General Assembly that , should the General Assembly adopt draft resolution A/C.3/62/L65/Rev.1 (as orally revised), preliminary additional requirements up to \$6,794,700 would be required under section 2, General Assembly Affairs and Economic and Social Council Affairs and conference management (\$4,895,900) and section 23, Human Rights (\$1,898,800) of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2008-2009. The Committee recommends that the General Assembly should take note of these preliminary estimates. Upon the conclusion of discussions and negotiations and the determination of the structure of the Durban Review Conference, including the regional preparatory meetings, detailed information on financial implications will be submitted.
