Palestine

Gaza's carnage is a painful reminder of the massacres perpetrated by the Zionist terrorist gangs against the Palestinian people six decades ago. Since its inception the Jewish state unleashed a chain of economic intimidation, mass destruction, massacres, and forcible removal of Palestinians from their homes and lands perpetrated according to pre-meditated plans by the Zionist leadership in fulfilment of their strategic objective of the creation of a pure national Jewish state. UN resolutions, peace plans and agreements to achieve a two-state solution have not succeeded and have been met with oral acceptance by Israeli consecutive leaderships while simultaneously working against them. The image of Palestinian children shocked by the sight of their killed friends and relatives implants the seeds of hatred and revenge. This is not the way to win the hearts and minds of current and future generations. It is unwise, foolish in the extreme and criminal.
