- Instead, we should wait for these 5 experts to submit their report to us and then analyze and discuss their paper. We should start to discuss on the necessity of establishing an Ad Hoc Committee only after this process. We cannot agree with the process in L.3, as we feel it pre-empts the conclusion of the paper by the 5 experts.
- Therefore, we cannot agree with L.3 and will-vote against it.
